Preamble	The "Standard Instructions - Handicap" document is to be read with, and forms part of, this Notice of Race.				
Invitation	The Organising Authority and the Host Club - The Royal Hamilton Amateur Dinghy Club (R.H.A.D.C.), are pleased to invite sailors to compete in the R.H.A.D.C. Anniversary Regatta.				
Eligibility, Entry & Fees	<p>The regatta is open to keelboats and yachts. Proof of insurance, to comply with SI 30.1, shall be required prior to registration being accepted. All boats shall race in the PHRF class.</p> <p>Registration shall be by delivering a completed entry form, and the registration fee, to the Sailing Office, no later than the day before competing in the first regatta.</p>				
Schedule of Races	<p>The regatta schedule shall be as indicated in "Appendix 3 –Schedule (Handicap)". One race shall be scheduled for the regatta.</p> <p>The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1030 hours on the scheduled race day. No warning signal shall be made after 1230 hours.</p> <p>Races Abandoned or Postponed shall be started as soon as practicable.</p> <p>Races not sailed on the scheduled race day shall not be rescheduled and shall be scored as void.</p>				
Venue & Courses	SI 7.1 is replaced with "The racing area will be the waters of Bermuda including outside the outer reef, with start area in the Great Sound."

Scoring & Prizes – Regattas	<p>Scoring shall be based on corrected time using time-on-time scoring.</p> <p>Boats shall be allocated to divisions and classes by the Race Committee, based on their handicap, boat type, sail plan, and the number of entries, all boats will be entered into the Overall Division.</p> <p>The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A shall apply with no score excluded.</p> <p>In addition classes shall be scored. Classes shall be comprised of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One-design boats, with three or more entrants. The scoring shall be based on their finishing order. • PHRF class fleet for all other keelboats. The scoring shall be based on their corrected time using their PHRF handicaps. <p>Prizes for the Anniversary Regatta shall be awarded to the first three boats in each of the classes; and to the first three boats overall.</p> <p>Prize-giving is scheduled to follow racing at 13:00 hours, at R.H.A.D.C..</p>
